

Welcome to Honors Precalculus! To prepare you for the fall semester I have created several assignments on DeltaMath to reinforce certain skills that will be needed for you to be successful. To register, follow the instructions below.

1. Visit www.deltamath.com
 - a. If you already have an account with your OLM email address
 - i. Go to **TOOLS** then **MANAGE LOGIN AND TEACHERS**
 - ii. Enter my teacher code: **721672**
 - iii. Select the **Pre-calculus Summer Assignment** section
 - b. If you do not have an account with your OLM email address
 - i. Select **Create Account**
 - ii. Enter my teacher code: **721672**
 - iii. Follow the instructions for creating your account
 - NOTE: Your account must use an OLM email. If you are new and have not received your email address by June 15, contact Ms. Miller at rmiller@mercycatholic.org
 - iv. Select the **Pre-calculus Summer Assignment** section
2. Complete the assignments at your own pace over the summer
 - a. I recommend you work on the assignments throughout the summer.
 - b. Take your time as you work on the assignments.
 - i. Each assignment requires you to correctly answer a certain number of questions.
 - ii. Incorrect responses reduce your current score, so be careful.
 - iii. Show your work as you complete the assignments.
 - c. All assignments will open on June 1 and are due August 8 by 11:59 pm (you should be asleep and ready for the first day of school by this time anyway)
3. Grading
 - a. This assignment will be graded using a 60/40 method
 - i. 60% of your grade is completion
 - This means completing the required number of questions, regardless of correctness.
 - ii. 40% of your grade is correctness
 - Did you get the required number of questions correct?
 - b. This assignment will count as your first quiz grade in the class
