



Signing In Directly to Pearson Digital Learning Platforms


You will have the option to sign in directly to the learning platforms by going directly to the platform websites.



1. Go to your Pearson learning platform and click **Log In**.
2. Click the EasyBridge  icon.
3. Type in the name of your district and select it from the drop-down list. Click **Go**.




4. Sign in to your SIS or district portal. This will take you to your learning platform.

 **Note:** Direct login to MathXL® for School is not available in your EasyBridge integration. You must login through EasyBridge.




Steps to Login Using Pearson (Secondary/Backup) Credentials

Under certain circumstances your primary login may not provide you with direct access to your courses. When this occurs, Pearson (secondary/backup) credentials can be used in place of the district login if this has been enabled for your district. Check with your teacher to verify you can obtain Pearson credentials. See steps below for how to use your Pearson credentials.

1. Go to the Pearson URL you would like to access, such as Pearson SuccessNet.
2. Click the login button.
3. Enter your Pearson credentials provided by your teacher.
4. Click the **Sign In** button.

 **Note:** Do not click on the EasyBridge icon. Your Pearson credentials will not work here.
